
The Behavioral Health Center is a place of healing and mutual respect. Any disruptive or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.

Thank you for choosing the Behavioral Health Unit!

We understand this is a challenging time and we are here to help. During your loved ones stay, we do our best to keep them and everyone safe on the unit.

To make this possible, we must limit the types of items that can be brought onto the unit when patients are admitted and during visitation times.

All personal items will be screened before admission to the unit. Items not allowed on the unit will be placed in lockers and returned at discharge.

Please check in with security at the front desk before inpatient visits.

Items allowed when admitted to the Behavioral Health Center:

- 3 t-shirts
- · 2 sweaters (no hoodies)
- 3 sweatpants (without strings) or 3 pairs of jeans
- · 3 pairs of underwear
- · 3 bras (without underwire)
- · 3 pairs of socks
- Shoes without shoelaces/strings (i.e. slippers and/or sandals)
- Books (softcover/paperback only) or magazines (without staples)

Items NOT allowed on the unit while admitted or during inpatient visitation times:

- Electronics (i.e. cell phones, chargers, laptops, etc.)
- Sharp objects (i.e. keys, nail files, clippers, hair clips, tweezers, etc.)
- · Hats, hair ties, hair clips, etc.
- Jewelry (i.e. watches, earrings, rings, earrings, etc.)
- Revealing clothing or clothing with inappropriate messages or images
- Belts
- · Outside food or drink
- Hygiene products (i.e. shampoo, conditioner, lotion, toothpaste, perfume, brushes/combs)
- Any alcohol, tobacco products or drug-related paraphernalia of any kind
- Metal or wire bound notebooks
- Writing utensils (i.e. pens, pencils, etc.)

Visitation

Before visitation, you will be searched by security. Any personal items not allowed will be placed in a locker. Minors under 18 years of age are not allowed on the unit for safety reasons.

Please ensure you are here on time for your visit. Safety is always our main priority. Should a safety issue arise while you are on the unit, you will be escorted off the unit accordingly while staff can address the issue.
